Thank you for your inquiry into the American Evangelical Christian Churches. The American Evangelical Christian Churches (AECC) is a Christian denomination founded in 1944 in Chicago, Illinois, with ministers and churches serving throughout the United States and many foreign countries. We have been called to serve those laboring in the front line ministry and to encourage you in your efforts to fulfill God's call upon your life in Christian service.

The AECC may be able to provide you with appropriate credentials and the opportunity for affiliation with others who share a like calling and who desire to fellowship with other Christian ministers and churches.

Application for Membership and references are required. You are asked to provide a primary pastoral recommendation from your Senior Pastor, a current AECC minister, or an established congregation. Your remaining references may include additional ministers, church elders, deacons, or other lay leaders. You may also include others who can attest to your Christian faith and practice. If you have any questions regarding your particular situation, please feel free to call and discuss them with our office personnel.

As of January 1, 2012, all new applicants must submit to a background investigation - the fee of which is to be borne by the applicant. The background investigation questionnaire will be sent to you after your application is received and temporary approval is given.

As of January 1, 2017, a new policy was instituted regarding licensed ministers (licensed after that date) who wish to seek ordination. It is further outlined on page two (2).

Federal (IRS) and State Agencies recognize our credentials. AECC MINISTERIAL LICENSING AND ORDINATION POLICY AND PROCEDURE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2012

Becoming a Licensed or Ordained Minister is a sacred trust and covenant made between the individual and the Lord, with the AECC given the authority and responsibility to oversee those who have answered and accepted the Lord's call upon their lives.

It is a responsibility to be entered into soberly and reverently – not for self, not for special status, not for a title – but to be the Lord's servant and be a servant to His people on Earth.

Therefore, the AECC has developed certain guidelines to help insure the integrity of the office of Minister and for continuity within the AECC.

Each position has its own requirements and will be discussed separately.

Licensed Minister (new or by transfer from another denomination):

Procedure:

- 1. The candidate is to fill out the Application for Membership form and mail it with the appropriate fee to their Regional Coordinator (see listing on page 4). The Application for Membership can be requested from the home office, from the Regional Coordinator, or it is available online at www.aeccministries.com.
- 2. Three letters of reference are required. Each must be completed and mailed to your Regional Coordinator.
- 3. A background check will also be required with the results sent to the main office of the AECC. This background check is done through a private company with none of the fee coming to the AECC. The fee for this service is to be borne by the applicant and is non-refundable. You will be billed separately for this service.

Once all of the above have been received by the Regional Coordinator, they will either meet with you face to face or conduct a preliminary telephone interview. They will also contact each of your references. Upon the Regional Coordinators recommendation, the application packet will then be sent to the AECC office. A Certificate of Licensure and clergy card will be mailed to those who are approved. Please allow six weeks.

Although you may assist another Ordained Minister, AECC Licensed Ministers are not granted the authority to officiate at any marriage. Only Ordained Ministers are allowed to do this.

If you are a new member and are seeking to be Ordained please note: the AECC requires new members to hold the office of Licensed Minister for at least one full year prior to becoming an Ordained Minister.

Those transferring from another denomination may be accepted as Ordained. However, the same steps outlined above still apply.

Ordained Minister (new or by transfer from another denomination):

Procedure:

Those wishing to apply to become an Ordained Minister of the AECC:

- 1. If you are currently a Licensed Minister with the AECC and have fulfilled your obligation of at least one year of service, you may apply for Ordination status if your ministry position warrants it. Follow Steps 1 and 2 under Licensed Minister procedure.
- 2. If you are seeking transfer from another denomination, follow Steps 1, 2 and 3 under Licensed Minister procedure.

In either case, your paperwork must be in the hands of your Regional Coordinator at least six weeks prior to your impending installation. That will allow sufficient time for your application packet to be mailed to the home office where it will be reviewed and will provide sufficient time for the AECC to prepare materials (Ordination Certificate, clergy card, etc.) for those who are approved. Once accepted, you will be required to attend the next Regional Conference in your area for a service of installation.

Automatic acceptance is not guaranteed and the final decision is per the AECC Board of Directors.

The AECC requires that at least one member of the Board of Directors conduct the installation service – assisted by the Regional Coordinator and other AECC Ministers in attendance. Note: Regional Coordinators do not have the authority to License or Ordain on their own.

The AECC Board of Directors has approved the following policy for AECC Licensed Ministers seeking Ordained Minister Status. This policy goes into effect January 1, 2017:

Licensed Ministers (licensed after the effective date) who are seeking Ordination are expected to meet the following requirements:

An ordained minister credential is required to perform the following sacerdotal services of the local church. (Under IRS guidelines these services include: baptisms, weddings, communion, teaching, spiritual counseling, baby dedications, administration of church affairs, and regular conducting of worship services. Ordination is not required to do all of them but is required for a majority of them.) (Note: Even though State laws may vary, the AECC requires a person be ordained in order to officiate a wedding.)

The AECC prefers to ordain at their Biennial International Conference. However, an individual may be ordained at a Regional Conference provided there is one of the AECC Board members there to officiate. In either case, the following criteria for ordination must be followed:

- A letter from the AECC licensed minister requesting ordination must be received. This is to be submitted in writing to the AECC Board of Directors at the AECC office.
- 2. The candidate for ordination must serve as a Licensed Minister for at least one (1) year before applying for ordination.
- 3. The Licensed Minister must satisfactorily complete two (2) AEBC courses prior to ordination. The first required course is "Ministerial Ethics and Etiquette". The second required course is your choice of one of the following: "Pastoral Ministry", "Church Administration", "Pastor to Pastor", "Pastors Practical Helps", or "Biblical Principles of Church and Personal Finance".
- 4. The AECC Board of Directors will instruct the Board Treasurer to evaluate the giving record of the licensed minister to see if they have supported the AECC financially beyond their annual renewal fee and if the AEBC course fees have been paid.
- 5. The Licensed Minister must have attended either one (1) Regional Conference or the Biennial International Conference during the time he/she was licensed.
- 6. A video conference with the AECC Board of Directors must also take place. This is for the Board to interview and evaluated if all requirements have been met before ordination can be conferred.

By majority consensus of the Board, the candidates request will either be approved or denied. The candidate will then be notified by mail of any action taken.

It is required that each and every AECC Licensed or Ordained Minister attend either their Regional Conference or the biennial AECC International Conference. If you are unable to do so, you must notify the home office as to the reason why.

This is done for several reasons.

The AECC has a responsibility to you. We are providing you with a ministerial covering, opportunities to help educate you and assist you in your ministry and to fellowship with other members so that you may share ideas and concerns with them and with us.

You also have a responsibility to the AECC. We want and need you to be an active part of the denomination, to strengthen it and foster its growth.

We want to walk together with you in ministry but it's a two-way street. Failure to either attend an annual regional or the biennial (every two years) international conference or notify the home office in writing may cause you to lose your credentials.

If living in the United States, please mail this form and the Application for Membership form, along with the nonrefundable application fee to the Regional Coordinator representing your area. Foreign applicants: please mail your application to the Director of Missions. Names and addresses are listed on page four of this form.

The nonrefundable membership application fee of \$60.00 (USD) should be sent in the form of a check or money order made payable to: American Evangelical Christian Churches. DO NOT SEND CASH. The membership fee is renewable each year based on the member's life and conduct, as well as maintaining a cooperative relationship with the ongoing ministry of the AECC.
